Legal protections and rights in Scots law

1 The patients Right Scotland Act 2011 (patients charter rights of the individual A **You have the right to be involved in decisions about your own care and treatment.**)

- NHS staff should not make decisions about your care and treatment without involving you in that decision.

- You can ask for a second opinion before you make a decision about your care and treatment, if you think you need it. Where possible, your request will be met B **You have the right to accept or refuse any treatment, examination, test or screening procedure that is offered to you.**

- If you can understand the information you are given and are capable of making a decision for yourself about the care or treatment you are offered, then you have the right to accept or refuse any treatment, examination, test, or screening procedure, or to take part in research.

2 Article 8 1998 Human Rights Act Everyone has the right to respect for his private and family life, his home, and his correspondence.
