



FOI447 - CCTV Details of Hospitals

I am requesting under FOISA CCTV details of hospitals and units that care for patients with mental health issues in your area.

Stratheden Hospital, Cupar, Lynebank Hospital, Dunfermline, Queen Margaret Hospital, Dunfermline and Whyteman's Brae Hospital, Kirkcaldy provide direct care for patients with mental health issues in Fife.

Specifically, what locations have CCTV installed outside and what are the reasons for this?

Queen Margaret Hospital, Dunfermline and Whyteman's Brae Hospital, Kirkcaldy have external CCTV cameras on site for the safety of staff, patients and visitors and to help with crime prevention and detection.

Lynebank Hospital, Dunfermline has external CCTV at Mayfield Unit & Daleview Unit for the safety of staff, patients and visitors and to help with crime prevention and detection.

What locations have CCTV installed inside and what are the reasons for this?

Queen Margaret Hospital, Dunfermline and Whyteman's Brae Hospital, Kirkcaldy have CCTV cameras installed internally (circulation spaces and public areas only) for the safety of staff, patients and visitors and to help with crime prevention and detection.

What locations do not have CCTV inside and what are the reasons for this?

With the exception of QMH and WBH none of the sites have internal cameras as clinical areas are not covered by CCTV for patient confidentiality.

What locations do not have CCTV outside and what are the reasons for this?

Stratheden Hospital does not have any CCTV as there are very few incidents to warrant a system at this time.
